- **Healthy Moms MATR event at CCHD on Thursday, October 26<sup>th</sup> from 10:00 AM-12:00PM-** Clarissa Johnson will lead educational information sessions on neonatal opioid withdrawal. Any mom can attend to learn how to have a healthy pregnancy.
- **Second Chance Recovery/Student Purpose Program Update:** We approached the Day Treatment Center Board and the board, as well as, Mr. Anderson were all very supportive. Mark, Lisa and Medea met with the board office and the Comprehensive Wellness Program for the Day Treatment Center was approved and we will be working towards getting this implemented.
- **Think Sharp Needle Disposal-** Reminder- There are currently two locations, the Emergency Room and the Murray North Fire Station. Jane Anne requested flyers to be passed out for the drop boxes.
- **Trauma Informed Care Training-** Very exciting news, attendance was maxed out!

- **Drug test kits for Calloway County Day Treatment Center-** The guidance counselor asked if we could donate drug testing kits to the Day Treatment Center. ITP students have to pass two drug tests to complete the program. 50 rapid cups cost \$650. We need clarification on if there is a drug test policy at Calloway and Michelle Hansen offered to look for a policy from the past. Sam Steger suggested buying and giving them to the Sheriff’s office and the Police department to give to parents.
- Purchase of an additional medication drop box to place at the Sheriff’s office
- FRYSCCE data collection- Regional Prevention Center sent out a survey combined report of parent results and Michelle Hansen shared with the group. Michelle will send to Nicole to share through email.
- Updates from coalition members
  - Michelle Hansen announced the parent work group parenting classes will start on October 12<sup>th</sup> from 5:30-9:00 at the KY Extension Office. The classes are for six weeks. The cost is \$40 per person or \$55 for couples. The price includes books and meals.
  - There will be a Trauma Informed Care Training held Tuesday October 17<sup>th</sup> from 8-12 at the MSU Paducah Regional Campus and it is free.
  - Miranda Terry discussed the Great American Smoke Out to be held at the Curris Center on November 16<sup>th</sup>, 2017 at 9:00 to provide health education related to tobacco use.
  - Jane Ann Turner and Morgan Carmen discussed a red ribbon promotion at the school. Cheerleaders threw out water bottles with red ribbons on them and read about what the red ribbon means. Morgan and Amber also announced that pencils with red ribbons on them would be passed on during Spirit Week at the middle school and the elementary school.
  - Cathy Morris announced that Elm Grove Church will be hosting a surviving the holidays class/support group. Dates were not given at the time of the meeting.
