2. Agenda topic: Approval of minutes from 10/17/16.

3. Agenda topic: Financial Reports – Total: \$48, 619.90 (City of Murray: \$11,39.24 / Ky-ASAP funding: \$37,221.66)

Deposit: Received first ½ of KY-ASAP: \$7,750

Expenses: \$200 website development, Kala, Mark and Nicole expenses from Addiction Symposium @ Baptist Health and \$359 sponsor ad on map with Chamber of Commerce.

Decision(s): Sam Steger made a motion to approve the minutes, Cathy Morris seconded the motion and all approved.

4. Agenda topic: Director's Report -- Stated report was mostly Old Business.

5. Old Business:

- **Think Sharp needle box project:** One box outside of MCCH Emergency and one outside of Murray Fire Department. Just waiting for approval and placement of boxes. Will send out promotional fliers when boxes are actually in the ground.
- **Data Collection:** Jennifer Siner has been contacting different programs in the community to broaden data collection. Autumn Brown, Health and Wellness' new intern, will pick up this project. Murray Independent completed their surveys for the KIP Data in 10th and 12th. Due to a communication issue, Calloway County Schools did not participate in the KIP Data this school year. Neither school reacted favorably about completing survey this year. Coalition will address this concern before next survey. There was discussion regarding the possibility of ASAP compiling a survey that mirrors

the KIP Data Survey and asking Calloway County High School to implement this school year.

- **CC-ASAP website:** Nicole reviewed/displayed the updates she has made on the CC-ASAP's website. Members were very pleased with the new look.
- **Library Program:** Need the following date filled 4/18 from 2:30 to 5:00.
- **Murray Ledger & Times article:** Amy brought attention to an article in 'In Our Backyard' regarding an interview with Nicole and Amy about CC-ASAP. The magazine was passed around to the coalition members.

6. New Business:

- **"Talk, They Hear You" campaign:** Initiated by 4-Rivers to encourage parents to start talking to their kids about drugs and alcohol. Samantha announced the development of a Facebook page. Samples of informational materials were passed around to the coalition members.
- **Events Calendar:** Nicole asked the members to send her events a couple of weeks in advance.
- **KIP Survey update:** Discussed in Old Business
- **Chamber of Commerce Map Project:** Discussed in Financial Report
- **Grant for Tobacco Free Schools: Calloway—**Amy reported the health department received a \$20,000 grant. Their focus is on Calloway County Schools as Murray Independent and Murray State are already smoke-free. In May of 2016, Michelle Hansen, Vicki Williams and Amy spoke to Calloway County Board of Education regarding their campus becoming smoke-free. The grant requires the implementation of a survey involving parents and the staff. Amy has tried to contact Mr. Settle regarding permission to send out this survey, but has not received any feedback. Suggestions were made regarding different ways to help convince the Calloway board to become a smoke-free campus.
- **Freedom from Smoking Classes: 5:30-6:30PM @ Center for Wellness—**Tuesday, January 3, 10, 17, 24, 26 and 31 and Tuesday, February 7 & 14. Note: Week four participants meet two days this week because this is their "quit smoking" week.

7. Other Business:

- **Addition Symposium in Paducah:** Mark, Kala and Nicole attended. Nicole stated that Mark had mentioned the importance of treating the trauma side of addiction as well...find out why they are using. If the trauma is not treated...chances are they are going to use again. Reached out to Marshall County Schools regarding their "Second Chance" recovery program. If they get in trouble for fighting, alcohol or drugs, they are enrolled in this recovery program. There was much discussion regarding the importance and different avenues of addressing these issues in schools.
- **Kala's spring semester class at Murray State** on substance abuse prevention has more than 30 students enrolled. She asked members to inform her of events her students could assist with as class assignments.
- **Sam Steger** reported plans with Calloway County High School to implement a Ghost Out event in April 2017.
